### **REMINDER!!:**

**"One Plus One" Meeting, May 6th from 6 pm - 8 pm, Barclay Recreation Center, 29th and Barclay.**

On May 6th, Celeste Amato, Director of the Mayor's Cleaner Greener Baltimore Initiative, will present the City's "1 Plus 1" trash and recycling proposal. The meeting will be held at the Barclay Recreation Center, 29th and Barclay from 6 pm - 8 pm. The 1 Plus 1 proposal would change the City's schedule for pick up of trash and recycling to one trash pickup and one recycling pick up *per week*. ***Note: The Benefits District will have a few large and small recycling bins and about 100 lids for sale (\$12, \$6 and \$3).***

*Current Status of the Legislation:* On April 21st the City Council's Committee on the Judiciary and Legislative Investigations held a 5 hour hearing on this proposal (Bill 09 - 284) and recommended several amendments. The Committee will take another vote on May 12th.
