Malicious Destruction of Property – *Phi Kappa Psi Fraternity House, 223 E. 33rd St.* – On May 18th between 2:00 AM and 10:00 AM, an unknown person threw a piece of concrete through the front window. An occupant of the house who was sleeping did not hear anything. No injuries. Investigation continuing.

Graffiti – *JHU Press Building, 2715 N. Charles St.* – Between May 23rd at 10:30 PM and May 24th at 3:10 PM, letters were spray-painted on the southwest corner basement door and on the canvas advertising sign mounted on the fence.
