- Safety The Northern District Police Department has not been able to provide off-duty
  officers for patrolling due to an employment shortage. They are working with the city-wide
  police departments in order to fulfill the missing patrols in the CVCBDMA district per our
  contract. This means that there is extra money, but that money will need to be used for
  safety services.
- Sanitation—rat abatement program will continue
  - Christian Wilson made a motion to have the Program Committee create an informational flyer on the proper disposal of waste to be distributed on the 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> blocks of Lovegrove. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.
