Revenue: We received

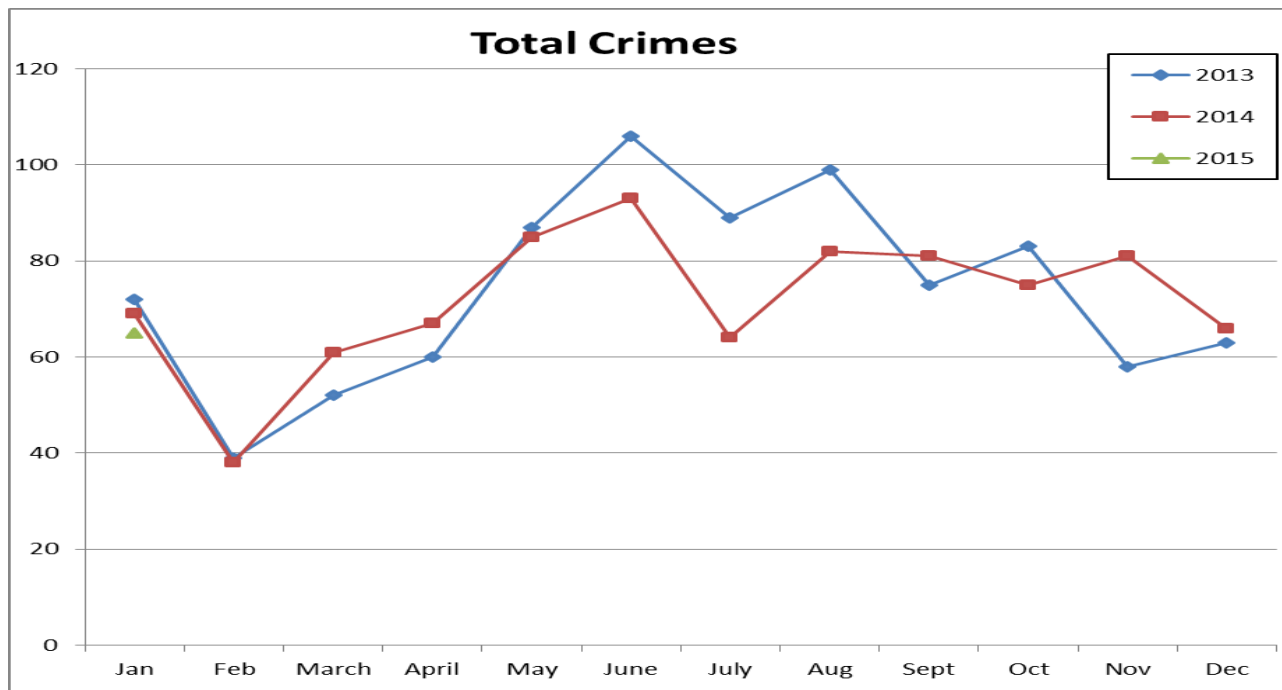
- \$520 - Greater Homewood Community Corp for enhanced sanitation services for Waverly Main Street

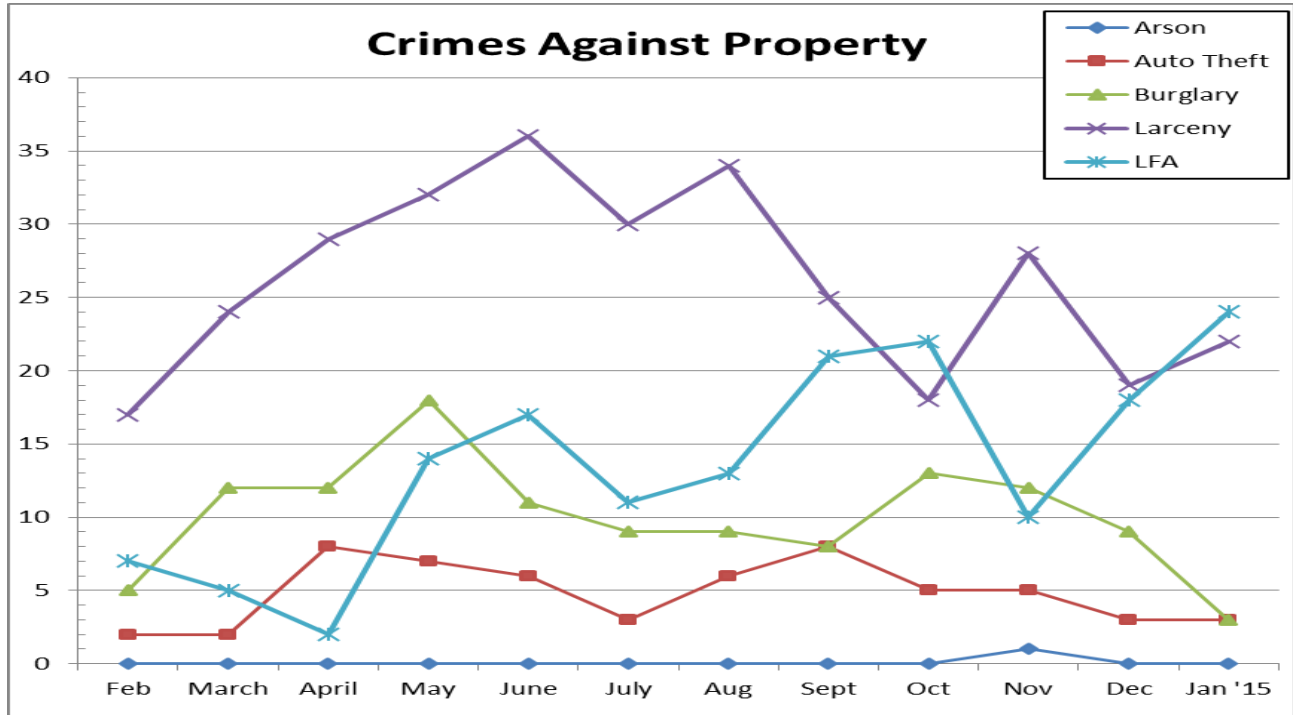

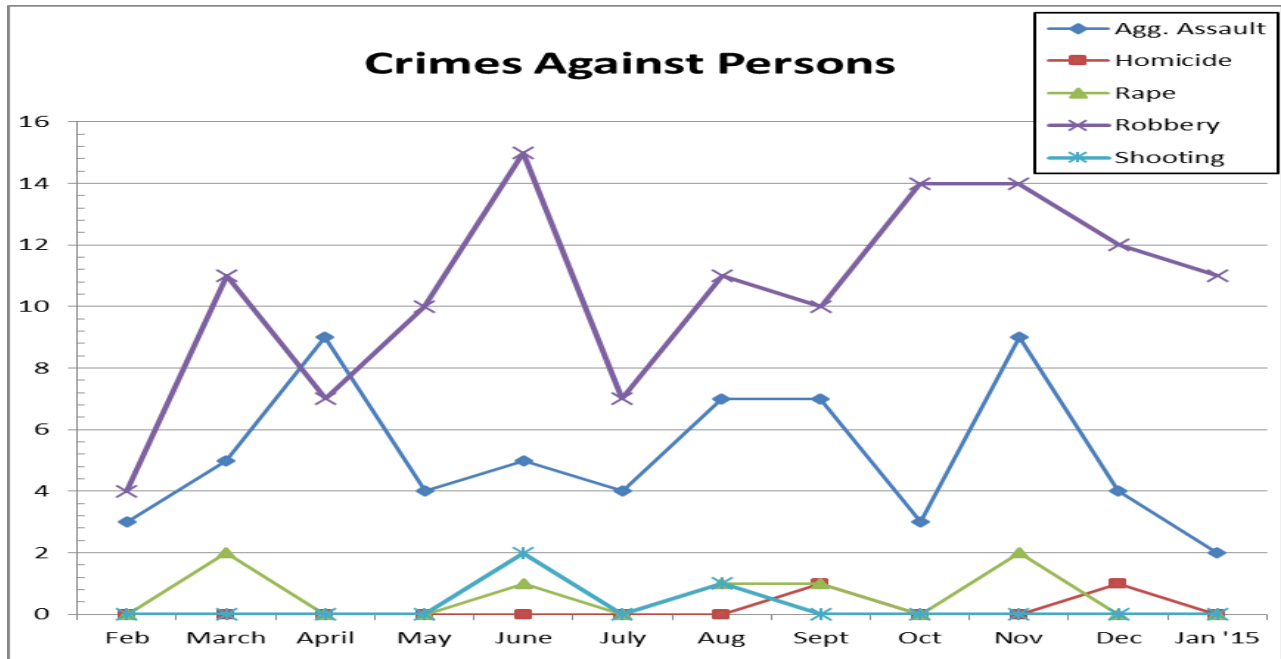
Total Crimes (3 year comparison)



Crimes against Property (monthly during past year)



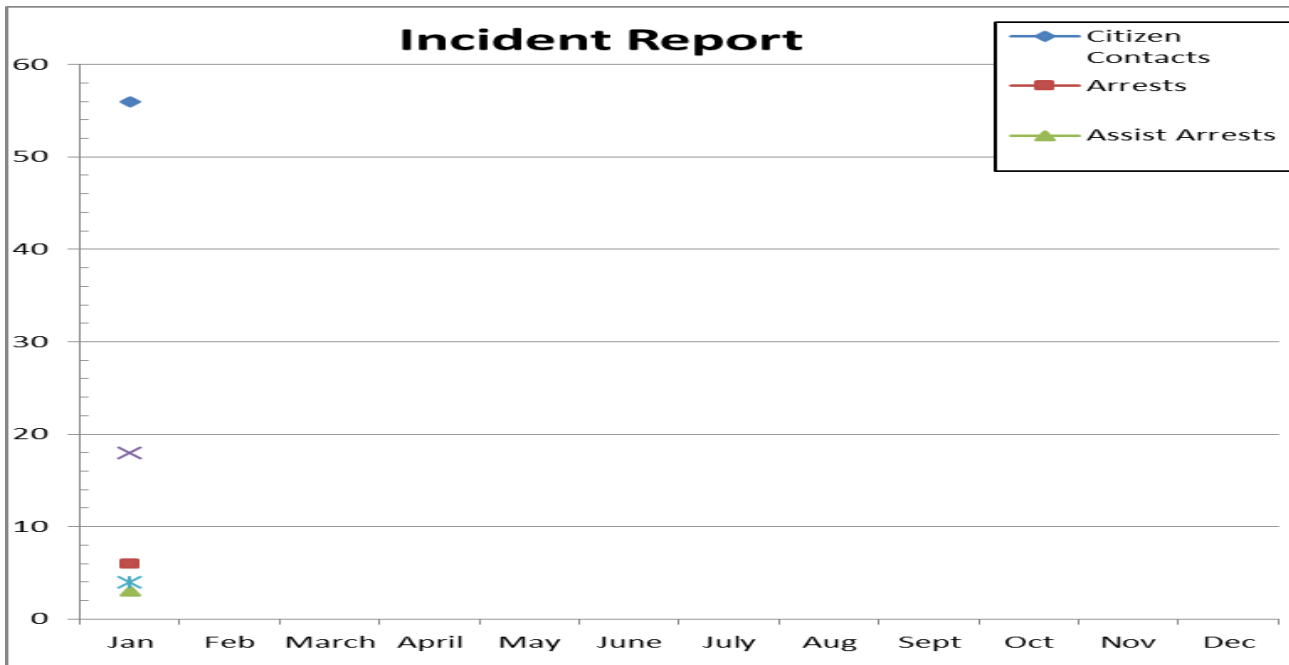
Crimes against Persons (monthly during past year)

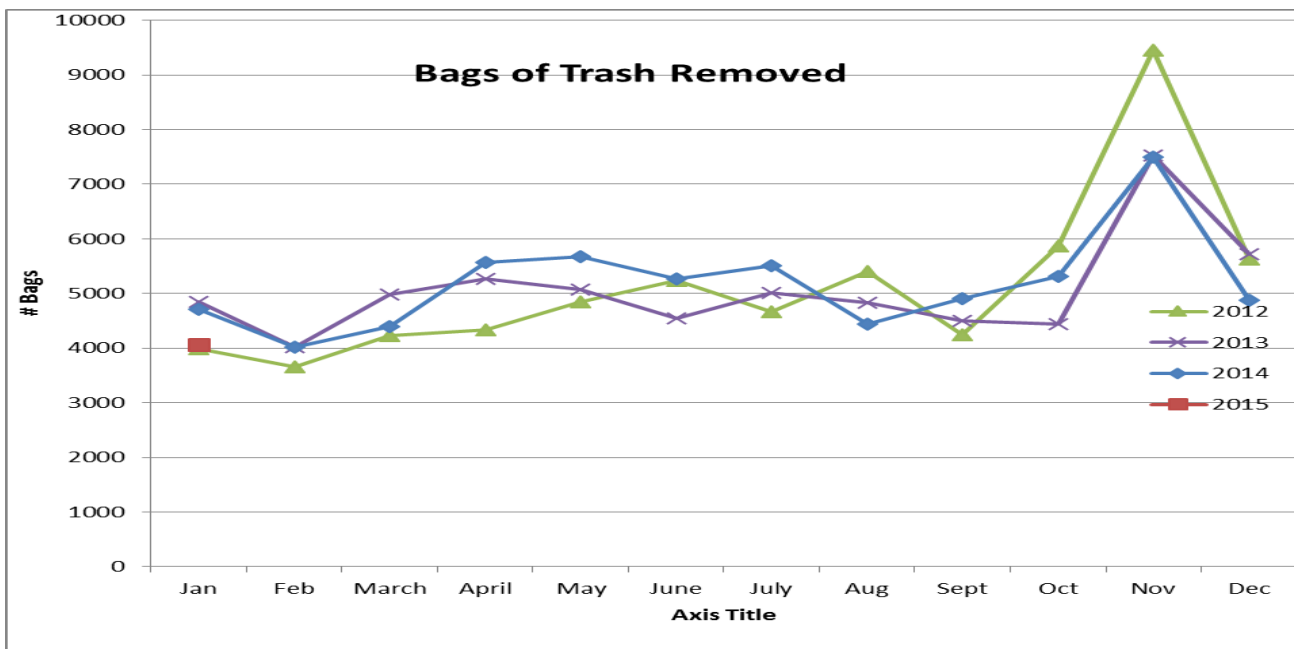

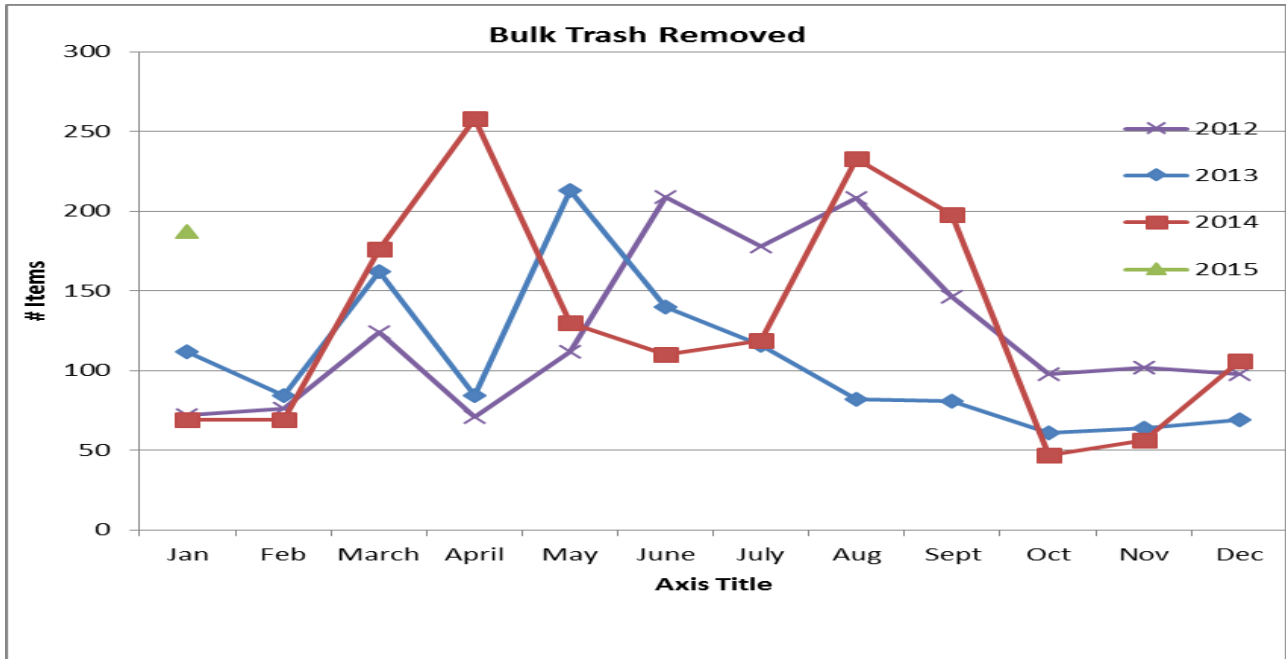
