### Package theft on rise during Holiday Season

With the rise of online purchases and deliveries, thieves commonly steal packages from front porches.

Utilize tracking information to anticipate the arrival of packages. **Request a signature confirmation of delivery and arrange to be home when they are delivered.**

If you know you are not going to be home when your package arrives, have your package delivered to a neighbor or friend for safekeeping.

The system allows Baltimore crime victims to file reports on-line for non-violent incidents such as car break-ins, vandalism and illegal dumping. Reports can also be filed on various platforms including a computer, tablet or smart phone. All the user has to do is go to the city police website, and click the reporting link and follow instructions. Each report is assigned an incident number, and the user gets a PDF file of their report that can also be used to report loss for insurance.

Post office boxes or other secure drop lockers are a good alternative to home delivery.

Safeway has a secure locker for Amazon.

Always look out for your neighbors. If you see something suspicious, dial 911.


