

APPLICATION PROCESS & TRAINING OVERVIEW

1. Applicants fill out required forms and return them to the Host Home Program Coordinator at Renees@stambros.org or St. Ambrose Housing Aid Center, 321 E 25th St, Baltimore, MD 21218.
2. Host Home applicants complete required training
3. Host Home Program Coordinator performs background checks and sends reference requests
4. Applicants have first interview with Host Home Program Coordinator
5. Host files are made available to youth for youth-driven selection
 - *Youth review host files, including the host letter to youth participants.*
6. Youth files are made available to Hosts
7. Applicants are chosen as Host Home Volunteers
8. Applicants have second interview with the Host Home Program Coordinator, Case Manager and Youth (in applicants' home)
 - *Review goals, expectations, etc*
9. Youth moves in
 - *Youth will reside with Host for UP TO 90 days*
10. Host received monthly stipends of \$400 to offset any additional costs while Youth resides with Host
11. Host Home Program Coordinator provides support to Hosts
